What time is the event?

12pm to 6pm on Saturday, Sept. 22, and Sunday, Sept. 23. The band plays from 1–5pm both days.

What is the cost?

\$10 per person, which includes a souvenir wine glass.

Is there food available?

Yes. We offer our own recipe sausages with homemade sauerkraut. We also offer a bistro plate with fruit and cheese, along with split pork shanks served with lentils.

Do you have other beverages besides wine?

Yes. We offer wine, beer, water and non-alcoholic beverages.

No outside food or beverages for this weekend.

When do you stomp?

We stomp four times during the day- 1:30, 2:30, 3:30 and 4pm.

Are wines available for purchase to take home?

Yes. Our gift shop will be open with discounts on wines to go.

Are children welcome?

Yes. But please keep in mind it is a winery and festival. Children must be attended at all times.

What else is going on during the event?

Winemakers give tours of the winery three times during the day.
