### **St Josef's 2008 Pinot Noir**

This is a great food wine -a fine balance between fruit & oak that continues to grow the longer you enjoy the glass. This vintage has a fine ruby color, and a light earthy, berry finish. \$5 glass \$15 bottle \$12 StJ Club

### **Kitara 2007 Pinot Noir- Barrel Select**

Not your typical '07- there's meat on the bone here...Rich body with red cherry, currant plus a hint of tobacco & bite. Long vanilla palette with a soft bite. \$5 glass \$18 bottle \$13 StJ Club

### **Kitara 2008 Pinot Noir - Barrel Select**

Lovely barrel select wine from a great year. Released in May of 2011 this has ruby fruit up front and long finish. Nice now & will age for years to come. \$5 glass \$20 bottle \$15 StJ Club

### **Kitara 2006 Pinot Noir- Barrel Select**

Great year produced a fine structure with smoky overtones of Oak. An elegant Pinot and this rich blend is great on its own or with a meal. One of our best wines .... \$7glass \$35 bottle \$25 StJ Club

### **'Starling Hill' '03 Pinot Noir**

An outstanding year for Pinot and this rich blend is great on its own or with a meal. Aged in small French oak barrels and then 3 years in the bottle! The family's favorite Pinot ever! \$7 glass \$40 bottle \$30 StJ Club

### **St Josef's 2005 Merlot**

A nice find - grown on our estate vineyards. Similar in body & style as an Italian Chianti, with subtle fruit & good structure with a soft finish and a nice round feel on the palate. Perfect for everyday! \$5 glass \$13btl \$10 Club

### **St Josef's 2005 Cabernet Sauvignon**

A tricky wine to grow in the Willamette Valley and there are years we can't produce. Light green pepper, black cherry with a smooth finish. Drinking well & will age. \$5 glass \$13 bottle \$10 StJ Club

### **Kitara 2006 Syrah- Barrel Select**

From the first Syrah vineyard in the valley—rich color, spicy texture and black fruit. Good with hearty meals & cheeses. Will age well and should be let to open before drinking. \$5 glass \$19 bottle \$15 StJ Club

### **Kitara 2004 Syrah- Barrel Select**

Syrah from Oregon? You betcha! Made in the classic Rhone style with deep color, light tannins with smoky notes , vanilla and spice. Enjoy- it's mellow & mature. \$5 glass \$20 bottle \$16 StJ Club

### **Kitara 2008 Syrah Barrel Select -**

Rich, deep color with raspberry notes and plum on the finish. More fruit forward than most of our wines- and with good results. Released for Fall '11. \$6 glass \$25 bottle \$20 StJ Club

### **KB 2004 Merlot**

Rich, smooth & supple- everything you expect in Merlot & more (*but not like the movie Sideways*). Fruit-forward with a beautiful silky finish. *Only 88 cases produced.* \$5 glass \$19 bottle \$15 StJ Club

### **KB 2006 Winemaker's Red**

This Cabernet Blend was sourced from Layne Vineyard who we've been working with since 1985. Rich, full bodied, with good tannins and structure. 118 cases produced. \$5 glass \$20 bottle \$16 StJ Club

## Kitara 2004 Reserve Chardonnay

Aged 8 months on oak and provides a complex, medium-bodied wine with a hint of apple and citrus.

We only made 4 barrels!

## St Josef's 2010 Pinot Rose'

Pinot Noir made as a white wine. Done in the traditional style; the juice is drained from the skins at harvest leaving a lovely soft, dry wine with perfect pink tones.

## St Josef's 2007 Chardonnay

All steel and made to be enjoyed with food, our Chardonnay is bright, with light citrus overtones and superb acid balance. A wine influenced by our 30 year old vines & very Burgundian in style. A multiple medal winner!

## Lilli Sparkling Chardonnay!

## St Josef's 2009 Pinot Gris

## St Josef's Riesling
