

St Josef's Grapestomping- Frequently Asked Questions

What time is the event?

Open from Noon – 6pm both days. The band plays from 1-5pm both days.

What is the cost?

\$10 per person, which includes a special St Josef's stemless wine glass.

There is great German music, wine tasting available and more.

Is there food available?

Yes- we have our own recipe sausages with home-made kraut. In addition we have a bistro plate with fruit & cheese. Sorry, no outside food for this event. *If you're looking for more food after the event you can go to several local restaurants the serve our wines including Filberts Farmhouse, Langdon Farms and Markum Inn.*

Do you have other beverages besides wine?

Yes- we have sparkling wine, beer, water and non-alcoholic beverages.

Can we bring a picnic?

No outside food or beverages for this weekend since this is a special event. You're welcome to come back another time when we don't have an event to enjoy a picnic at the pond.

When do you stomp?

We stomp at least 3 times during the day, 1:30, 2:30, 3:30 . And now we've added many new stomping opportunities because we're having three stompings at one time! Each stomping needs a group of 4 to make it work.

Do we need to make a reservation to stomp?

No, come on in! We draw names out of a hat from interested people who want to stomp. While not everyone will get a chance to stomp- nearly all can participate and help.

Are wines available for purchase to take home?

Yes our gift shop will be open and there will be special discounts on wines to go.

Are children welcome?

Yes- but please keep in mind it is a winery and festival. Children need to be attended at all times.

What about dogs? We love dogs, but they should **not come** to the festival.

Is there parking?

Yes, we have FREE parking areas situated on both sides of our property. We do ask that you CARPOOL to the event so that you can have a designated driver and we can have ample

parking for all. It is NOT a good weekend for a car / camper / RV rally event since the parking is limited.

Is there camper/trailer/RV parking?

Sorry, no.

Can we pick grapes?

No. Our farm has been certified organic and we can't risk the introduction of other things into the vineyards.

What else is going on that day?

The winemakers will be giving tours of the winery a couple of times during the day.

There is a special wine tasting station to try our newest releases.
